Registration Information

Madison Squash Association, Inc. is a non-profit organization that (MSA) offers squash leagues and events throughout the year at Nielsen Tennis Stadium on the University of Wisconsin campus. All interested adults are eligible to participate. MSA leagues provide competition in both singles and doubles matches.

Squash League is about friendly competition and building relationships between players, so we reserve the right to decline to register any person with a history of disruptive conduct (erratic attendance, argumentative behavior, and failure to wear mandatory eye protection and/or poor sportsmanship). Registration does not guarantee placement in a league. Our goal is to have a competitively balanced league that allows players of different ability levels to participate and build new friendships.

How to Register:

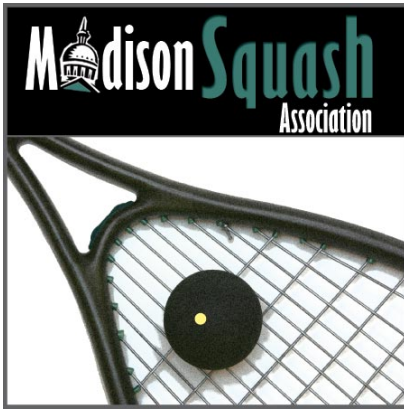
Registration is available online or by completing the form below and emailing to info@madisonsquash.org. Payment of registration fees is also available online or mailing a check. Payment must be collected before you begin league play. Questions regarding registration can be sent to the above address as well. Please make checks payable to the Madison Squash Association.

All players are required to sign the liability waiver mandated by UW Madison below as a condition of participation; UW faculty and staff must also pay the Nielsen Facility Access fee. Policies and Procedures:

Participants provide their own racket, goggles and singles balls. We play with a double yellow-dot international ball for singles; the doubles ball is a red-dot hard ball, which MSA maintains a supply. All players are required to wear non-marking court shoes. All participants in leagues should have played squash at least a few times previously. All league matches will count towards the Madison Squash Association's ladder. Proper courtesy and conduct is expected at all times. Lockers and change facilities are available.

The Madison Squash Association requires the use of eye protection during all league play. We strongly recommend eye protection that conforms to the requirements of the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) Standard F803. Types of eyewear that are not satisfactory under the ASTM F803 standard due to eye-injury risk include streetwear (fashion) spectacles and safety eyewear produced for industrial and educational or laboratory work. All participation is at the player's own risk. The Madison Squash Association does not provide individual accident insurance for participants. The Madison Squash Association will not assume responsibility for the safety of persons or equipment and shall not be held liable for any damages or injuries incurred by players or equipment during league play.



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Release of Liability

In consideration of my participation in a voluntary squash program sponsored by "Madison Squash Association, Inc." at the Nielsen Tennis Stadium at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, I do hereby release the Madison Squash Association, Inc. and the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System, its officers, employees and agents, from any and all liability for damage to or loss of personal property, sickness, injury or death from whatever source, which might occur while participating in such activities.

I understand the risks of athletic participation which include, but are not limited to, muscle strains, pulls and tears, shin splints, broken bones, strains, sprains, fatigue, and even death. I agree to abide by appropriate safety norms and to conduct myself in a safe and responsible manner and be respectful of my fellow participants. I understand that participation is voluntary and I freely choose to participate. I attest and verify that I am physically fit to participate in this event. I understand that the University does not provide medical coverage for my injuries and I agree to be responsible for any medical costs that I might incur during this activity.
